

ARTICLE VII

Officers

Section 1. The officers of the MOMA shall be a President, President-Elect, Immediate Past President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Said officers will perform the duties described below, and additional or different duties shall be imposed or required as needed by the Board of Directors. Except as herein otherwise provided, said officers shall also perform such duties as those specified in the parliamentary authority herein specified.

Section 2. **President:** The President shall be the Chair of the Board of Directors and of the Executive Committee and shall perform the duties usually pertaining to the office of President. The President shall nominate, subject to approval by the Board of Directors, all appointed officers and chairs of departments, bureaus, and committees, unless otherwise specified in these bylaws or by the Board of Directors. The President may be a delegate to the AOA House of Delegates.

Section 3. **President-Elect:** The President-Elect shall, in addition to duties as member of the Executive Committee, be acquainted with the duties of the office of President, and with all the functions and workings of the Association, in order to better serve the Association as President.

Section 4. **Secretary:** The Secretary is custodian of the records of the Association and shall keep accurate minutes of both the membership, Executive Committee, and Board meetings.

Section 5. **Treasurer:** The Treasurer shall supervise all the MOMA financial activities, keep an accurate and detailed account of all financial records of the MOMA, and review and report on the financial state of the MOMA at the annual meeting or when requested by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall also assist in the collection of dues and assessments of the Association.
